# ABOUT OUR SOCIETY

## MEETINGS

The Executive Committee meets in our museum at 12 noon on the first Saturday of every month (except January). Members are always welcome to attend and participate in these meetings.

## SPEAKERS

We have a guest speaker on the first Saturday of every month (except January and December) at 2:00 pm in the museum. The subjects are varied and deal mostly with some aspect of history. These talks are open to members and visitors. The talk is followed by light refreshments and a chance to socialise with members and talk to the speaker.

There is no charge for these talks but donations are always welcome as they assist with costs involved in mounting our different displays.

## VOLUNTEERING

**MUSEUM:** The Museum Committee meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the museum, commencing at 10:00 a.m. These meetings are to plan and organise future displays, and discuss and attend to any matters concerning Museum management. Members are also rostered for museum duty as guides on the days we are open.

**ARCHIVES/LOCAL HISTORY:** This is part of the Museum Committee's responsibilities and members help with care of and cataloguing our archives as well as undertaking research.

**ORAL HISTORY:** This is also part of the Museum Committee's responsibilities and members undertake the recording of oral histories of people who are or were associated with the City of Canada Bay Local Government Area. They also carry out transcribing or logging the tapes for future reference.

**WALKER ESTATES:** This committee is concerned with the preservation of the two historic Walker Estates - Yaralla (Dame Eadith Walker Hospital) and Thomas Walker Convalescent Hospital (Rivendell). Members plan and assist with the Open Days held on the estates each year as well as organising tours for various clubs and societies. Meetings for this group are called when needed. We are always in need of guides who can take groups of people on tours of the grounds when needed.
